Project Objective:

The objective of this project is to improve the hygiene of Narayi Community in Kaduna, Nigeria by instilling attitudinal and behavioural change as well as creating sustainable change in the indiscriminate disposal of waste in our drainages/streets.

The Problem:

Narayi Kaduna, Nigeria suffers from indiscriminate disposals of all kinds of waste. These wastes are disposed into our drainages and streets by residents or passerby. Drainages are there to ensure that waste water and sewage is transported neatly to disposal points so as to keep the environment clean. Residents regularly dump their waste in gutters, and this clogs the gutters and prevents the flow of water, causing the gutters to overflow. To think that they wait until it is raining to do so with a wrong notion that the rain will wash it away is a serious issue of ignorance. When this happens and it rain heavily, flood occurs. If it does not rain water become stagnant and become a breeding ground for mosquitoes. Residents of this community will continue to live in poor hygiene condition if measures are not taking.

Strategy:

Shared Humanity Foundation (SHF) applies community-based collaboration in working to bring about community development. Our personnel will work to raise community-based volunteers so as to bring about sustainability of the project. We will do raising awareness of the health risk the challenges of indiscriminate disposal of wastes can caused.

SHF is to work simultaneously with waste management agents, community heads and community law enforcement outfits on improving and sustaining clean and healthy lifestyles as well discuss measures to ensure to engage residents. We will via our collaboration identify and train key stakeholders, community-based volunteers and heads of groups and market places. In order to create a wider impact, we will work together with other community-based organizations, faith-based organization, residents and key stakeholders to advocate for sustainable waste management system from the government.

Activities:

- Organize 1-day intensive trainings for 10 participants selected from our collaboration.
- Organize 1-day Train-The-Trainer for 5 distinguished trainees.
- Conduct 2 follow-up and feedback seminars for training participants
- Organize meeting to discuss measures for advocacy with community-based organizations, faith-based organization, residents and key stakeholders
- Provide continuous assistance to the community

Project Outputs:

- Raised 50 community-based volunteers
- Awareness created amongst 2000 residents
