The local African women in Takwai village Upper Bayang Sub Division have been pounding their palm nuts manually using a mortar and pestle for many hours, this is very tedious for them, and keeps them very tired to the extent that they can not perform their marital sexual duties to their husbands at night, resulting in marital problems.

So therefore, a milling machine for palm nut will help reduce the work load of these women, giving them time to meet their marital duties.
